	Stencila (Sponsored Projects Program): With the support of Code for Science and Society, Stencila secured seed funding from the
	Alfred P. Sloan Foundationin 2016. In the 2016/2017 year, Stencila grew from a prototype into an integrated platform for reproducible
	research with a growing number of contributors and an online community of over 60 active members who engage in discussion on
	over 50 topics related to Stencila, and more than 500 followers on Twitter. Code for Science and Society has supported Stencila with
	grant writing, outreach, community development, connections to beta-testers, and running a serices of in-person events that reached
	over 50 key community members. They have successfully managed and coordinated a team of nine open source developers and
	started building a growing community of over 200 users, beta testers, developers, and partners.

	The Dat Project (Foundational Technology Program): In May 2017, we completed and deployed the Dat desktop application, registry,
	and web viewer for Dat. Users can register, login, and publish Dat archives on the registry. People can also preview Dat archives in
	the browser and on the desktop application, a key component for using Dat without knowledge of the command line. During this time,
	the open source community of developers grew to over 70 with a robust online community of over 150 chat channel members, more
	than 7,000 Twitter followers, and regular community engagement on all Dat Project communications. This work was funded by the
	John S. and James L. Knight Foundation and was successful in making Dat more appealing to a broader and less technical audience
	that included a key community of librarians, researchers, and journalists affiliated with three major institutions and the DatRescue
	movement. During the reporting period our team launched exciting partnerships with three key organizations in the library and data
	preservation space which will build on this foundation.

	Outreach and Education (Collaborative Communities Program): Over the 2016/2017 reporting period, we conducted six workshops

	these events ranging from 25 to 75 participants. In Portland Oregon we helped to organize a popular monthly javascript programmers
	meet-up called Donut.js, which typically hosts approximately 50 participants at each monthly meeting. To raise awareness of data
	preservation issues and teach data science skills, we collaborated with regional partners to host three larger events: csv,conf,v3 (300
	participants), DataRescue PDX (150 participants), and Open Data Day (100 participants). These data-centric events included lectures
	and hands-on skill building workshops. Taken together, these Code for Science and Society events attracted over 700 attendees from
	research and scholarly disciplines, public data, and civic tech. This helped us build bridges with related projects and grow the
