Foundational Technology Program - The Dat Project: CS\&S was awarded a grant from Mozilla's Open Source Support fund to enhance documentation and user resources for the Dat Project. This work engaged members of the Dat community to write documentation, including How Dat Works, and convene users and working groups. We also hosted a Mozilla-Ford Open Web Fellow to work on demystifying decentralized technology, resulting in our fellow's work at runyourown.social. In May 2018, Dat created a consortium of projects using the software to steward the community forward and encourage collaboration and develop common goals.

Collaborative Communities Program - Outreach and Education: We continued to focus our work in this
area on developing in-person events and online content to support the open public interest
technology community. Open Source Alliance for Open Scholarship (OSAOS) meetings resulted in a
collection of resources at osaos.codeforscience.org. We continue to host meetings for project
leaders adjacent to conferences such as csv,conf to develop their skills, project strategy, and
strengthen collaborations. Support from the Gordon and Betty Moore foundation allowed us to
research sustainability in open source research-driven software. This community-focused work helped
us build bridges with related projects and grow our understanding of how to best support
mission-aligned communities and projects.
